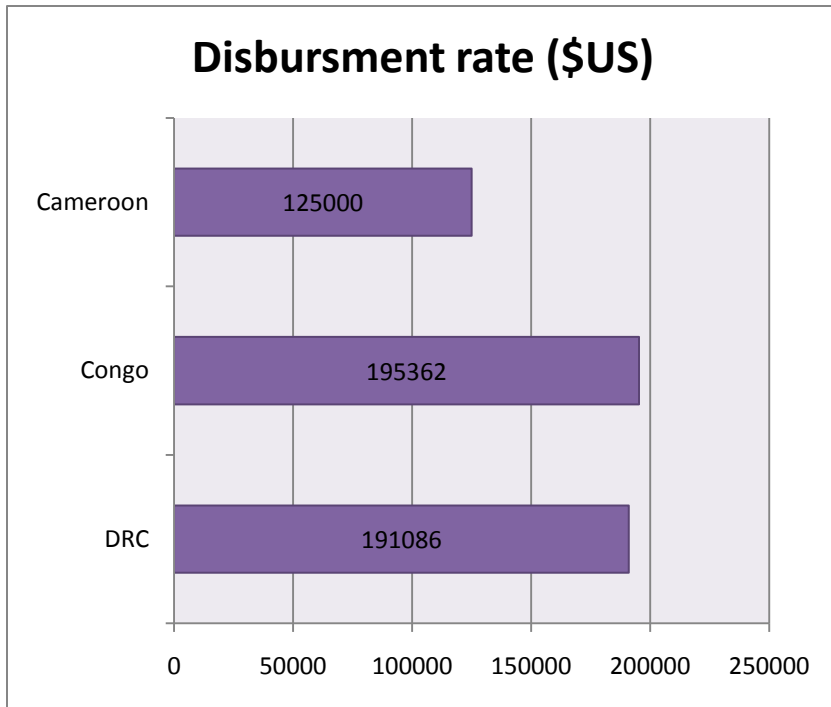


FCPF Status in Congo Basin Countries

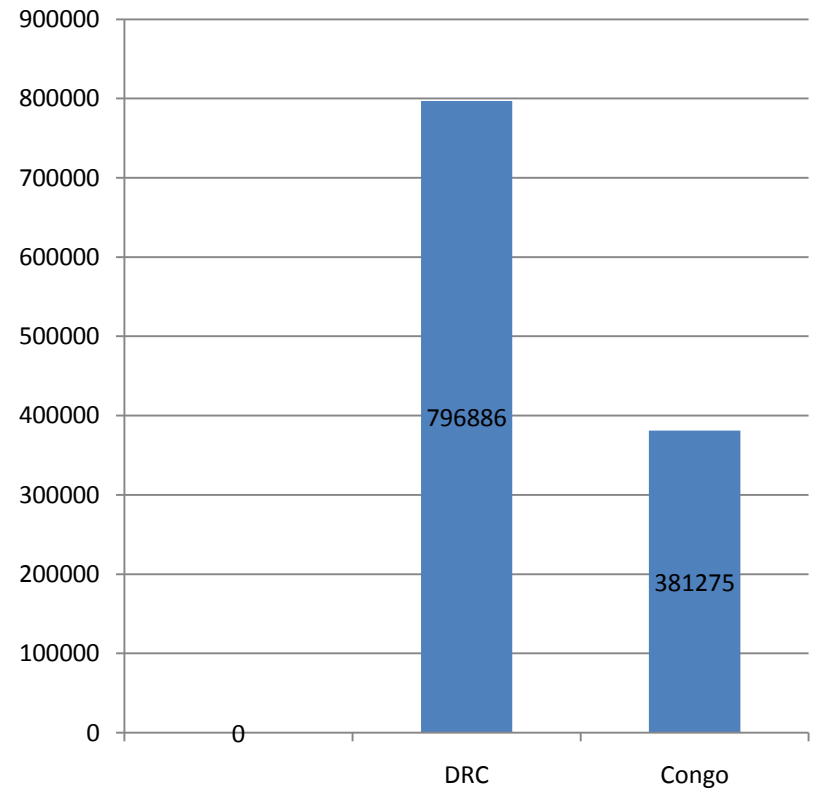
REDD Country	Process status
Cameroon	The US\$ 200,000 formulation grants was signed in 2010. The draft R-PP was submitted informally in August 2012. R-PP tentatively expected early 2013.
CAR	The R-PP was endorsed by the Participants Committee. Country is likely to work with the UNDP as Deliver Partner.
DRC	R-PP in implementation. Mid term review took place in June 2012. Country requesting additional funding from FCPF at the Brazzaville meeting in October.
Equatorial Guinea	Inactive. The country did not sign the Participation Agreement.
Gabon	Inactive at present
Republic of Congo	R-PP reviewed in March 2010. A US\$3.4 million grant to support key activities was signed in January 10, 2012 and is currently funding the REDD Coordination, studies and capacity building.
