






FCPF Status in Congo Basin Countries

| REDD Country | Process status |
|-------------------|---|
| Cameroon | The US\$ 200,000 formulation grants was signed in 2010. The draft R-PP was submitted informally in August 2012. R-PP tentatively expected early 2013. |
| CAR | The R-PP was endorsed by the Participants Committee. Country is likely to work with the UNDP as Deliver Partner. |
| DRC | R-PP in implementation. Mid term review took place in June 2012. Country requesting additional funding from FCPF at the Brazzaville meeting in October. |
| Equatorial Guinea | Inactive. The country did not sign the Participation Agreement. |
| Gabon | Inactive at present |
| Republic of Congo | R-PP reviewed in March 2010. A US\$3.4 million grant to support key activities was signed in January10, 2012 and is currently funding the REDD Coordination, studies and capacity building. |




Status of disbursement in few CB countries
