The book *Central African Forests Forever* offers an inspiring overview of opportunities and solutions to preserve the Congo Basin forests and their megabiodiversity. The book examines the Congo Basin forests from many viewpoints: economically, socially and ecologically. It is an intriguing mix of eyewitness reports, interviews and opinions of experts, most of them native to Central Africa itself.

Renowned scientists have contributed to the book with a chapter. Among them are Professor Godwin Kowero at Cgiar and president of the Africa Forest Forum; Professor Alphonse Maindo of the University of Kisangani; dr Isilda Nhantumbo of the International Institute for Environment and Development IIED; Dr Peter Minang of the World Agroforestry Centre; Dr Kevin Njabo of the Center for Tropical Research at the University of California, Los

Angeles (UCLA) and Professor Bill Laurance of James Cook University and Director of the Centre for Tropical Environmental and Sustainability Science (TESS).
